



Information for Individual Pageant Participants attending a Costume Try-on Day

This year's Pageant will be held on Saturday December, *starting at 10.30am*

- This costume is being lent to you for use in the Mt Barker Christmas Pageant and **must not** be used for any other purpose. Please treat costumes with respect and report any damage on return.
- Please come to the Football Club change rooms at the Mt Barker Oval on Wellington Rd, dressed in your costume (if issued already), to collect any accessories and have your face painted (optional).
- **MAKEUP** artists will be on hand from 8.15 to 10.15am. Please attend in the timeslot allocated as otherwise we may not be able to accommodate you. Please bring the timecard with you.
- **ACCESSORIES** such as wigs, hats, clown toys etc will be given out in the makeup/costuming area.
- **Please be on your assigned float, in costume and makeup, no later than 10.15am.**
- Please take all private belongings with you as there is **no access** to the change rooms after the pageant.
- **IN THE EVENT OF CATASTROPHIC FIRE CONDITIONS** forecast on the day of the pageant for the Mount Lofty Ranges, the Mt Barker pageant will be cancelled.
- Please see the attached **INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY** for full details.
- In the case of pageant cancellation, please return costumes to the Town Hall on the Saturday morning between 9am and 12 noon.
- **ALL COSTUMES MUST BE RETURNED BY 1.00PM ON PAGEANT DAY TO THE TOWN HALL IN GAWLER ST, WHERE CHANGE ROOMS AND MAKEUP REMOVAL EQUIPMENT WILL BE AVAILABLE.** Do not leave your change of clothes in your car as driving back to the Town Hall to return your costume will be impossible!

A note for Parents:

- Please do not let children wear the costume to play in before pageant day.
- Waiting on the floats can get warm if it is a sunny day, so please ensure all participants have a bottle of water – sunscreen will be available in the costume/makeup area.
- Marshals will be discharging people from the floats in Walker Street near the McDonald's corner. Please ensure arrangements are made for collecting any child participating from here as soon as possible.
- Please ensure all small children are carrying a mobile phone number to enable the Marshals to contact a parent in the event of a child being left in the waiting area.
- Clowns HAVE AN IMPORTANT FUNCTION. They make people feel happy by performing. Have fun, fill in the gaps if there is a hold-up, and help keep children behind the blue lines. ENJOY!!
